About Westbrook

Urban Saints Westbrook is a residential centre suitable for church, youth and school groups, set in 18-acres of mixed parkland near Ryde, on the Isle of Wight. Westbrook provides a safe and fun environment, founded on Christian beliefs. Westbrook can also provide a place where young people can express their faith and have the tools to learn more about it.

Purpose of the Role

We are looking for a dedicated and reliable Housekeeper to join our team at Westbrook, a residential centre on the Isle of Wight. This is a fixed-term, part-time position, offering 30 hours per week. The successful candidate will play a key role in maintaining a clean, safe, and welcoming environment for all those visiting and staying at the Centre.



Key Responsibilities

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Ensure all areas of the Centre, including bedrooms, communal spaces, and bathrooms, are cleaned to the highest standards.
- Perform regular cleaning duties, including dusting, vacuuming, mopping, and washing windows.
- Carry out laundry duties, including washing, drying, folding, and ironing linen.
- Maintain cleaning equipment and supplies, ensuring stock levels are managed and orders are placed when necessary.
- Follow health and safety guidelines and ensure the cleanliness of the environment complies with regulations.

Health and Safety

- Ensure a safe and hygienic living space by adhering to health and safety standards.
- Infection control: follow strict hygiene practices to prevent the spread of germs, including proper use of cleaning solutions and disinfectants, and adhering to infection control protocols.
- Report any maintenance issues or hazards promptly to the Operations Manager.
- Assist in keeping fire exits and emergency routes clear and accessible at all times.

Key Responsibilities (continued)


Supporting visitors and guests at Westbrook

- Create a positive, supportive environment by maintaining cleanliness and order in the living spaces.
- Work collaboratively with other team members to ensure the well-being of those on site.
- Respect the confidentiality of visitors and guests.

Other

- Attend weekly Westbrook team meetings and regular Urban Saints team meetings, and other Urban Saints commitments as reasonably required.

The above list of job duties is not exclusive or exhaustive, and the post holder may be required to undertake other duties that reasonably fall within the nature of the role and responsibilities of the post. There will be occasional out-of-hours work required.




About You

You will be a compassionate, reliable, and hardworking individual who is dedicated to maintaining a clean, safe, and supportive environment. The ideal candidate will be someone who takes pride in their work, demonstrating attention to detail and a strong commitment to hygiene and safety standards. They should be approachable, patient, and respectful, able to work both independently and as part of a team. A genuine understanding of the needs of guests on site, including young people, along with a desire to contribute positively to their well-being, is essential. Sensitivity, confidentiality, and an understanding of safeguarding principles will also be key in ensuring a comfortable, welcoming atmosphere for all.

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Good time management and organisational skills.
- Friendly, approachable, and able to build good working relationships with staff and residents.
- Sensitivity to the needs of young people and an understanding of safeguarding principles.
- Ability to follow cleaning schedules.

- Proven experience in a cleaning or housekeeping role, ideally in a residential or care setting.
- Basic knowledge of health and safety regulations related to cleaning.
- Understanding of infection control practices and the ability to follow safety guidelines.
- Experience working in a residential centre (desirable).
- First aid training (desirable).

- Good communication skills to interact with guests, visitors and staff.
- Flexibility to adapt to changing needs and priorities.
